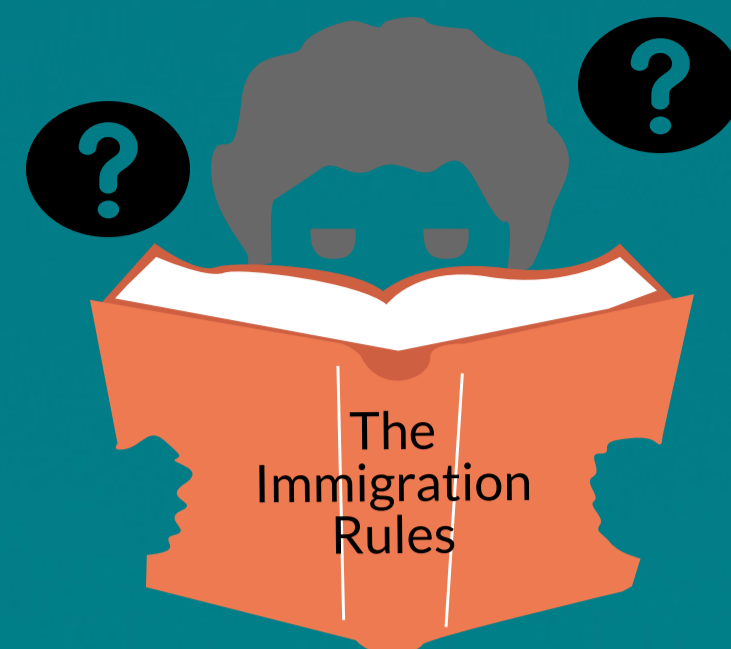


The Law Commission wants to make the Immigration Rules simpler and needs your help
